Qassim University's fourth campaign "Awareness, Health and Education", which was held at the Qubba Center in Al-Asyiah Governorate, over a period of five days, presented 247 diverse programs, benefiting 30341,<> beneficiaries, in various fields of legitimacy, education, medical clinics, dentistry, health and nutrition, in addition to training and skill programs, veterinary clinic, optometry clinic, medical laboratories, radiology, physiotherapy and first aid.

The programs provided by the university to the people of the Qubba Center and its surroundings also included awareness of the harms of drugs and their danger to the individual and society, in addition to recreational and sports programs, where the campaign was supervised and implemented by more than 600 university employees and students, who formed 17 committees and work teams specialized in the medical, scientific, legal and educational fields, in addition to the organizational and executive committees, where the activities and events of the campaign were distributed to its headquarters in the Celebrations Center in the Qubba Center, boys' and girls' schools, mosques, mosques and government departments.

This campaign comes in its fourth edition, which was held more than 150 km from the university's main headquarters in Buraidah, within the framework of the university's keenness to provide community services to all the people of the Qassim region and reach them in their places, as the university has previously provided three versions of this campaign in several governorates in the Qassim region.

Today, Sunday, the programs and events of the university's campaign "Health, Awareness and Education" in its fourth edition were launched at the Qubba Center in Al-Asyiah Governorate, under the patronage of His Royal Highness Prince Dr. Faisal bin Mishaal bin Saud bin Abdulaziz, Governor of Qassim Region, and with the support and follow-up of His Excellency Prof. Dr. Abdulrahman bin Hamad

Al-Dawood, President of the University, where the campaign is based in the celebration center in the Qubba Center, 150 km from the university's main headquarters.

This comprehensive qualitative campaign stems from the university's leading role in the field of social responsibility, as the university aims to contribute to instilling positive concepts, belonging to the homeland and serving it, and to protect young people from the paths of extremism, deviant ideas and wrong behaviors, as well as to support the quality of life through medical programs, health and psychological awareness, and to raise the level of personal skills and self-abilities to support educational and cognitive achievement.

For his part, Prof. Dr. Ahmed bin Ibrahim Al-Turki, Chairman of the Executive Committee of the campaign, explained that the university began preparing for this campaign 6 months ago by forming more than 14 committees, including the organizational, scientific and executive committees, which specialized in preparing all the various programs and events required by the campaign, as well as equipping the headquarters of its implementation, preparing training halls, equipping the housing of the teams implementing the programs, subsistence them, preparing publications and media coverage, and a women's committee specialized in women's programs was formed and followed up on their implementation.

He added that more than sixty members of the university's employees organized in these committees, and worked with all seriousness to accomplish the tasks assigned to them, pointing out that the number of implementers of the campaign's programs and events has reached six hundred university employees, students and students, and the number of programs and events exceeded 240 programs and events, which are implemented at the campaign's headquarters and in a number of schools, mosques and government departments in and around the Qubba Center.

Al-Turki said that the programs that will be presented throughout the days of the campaign vary between the legitimate programs, which amounted to (57 programs), educational (26 programs), as well as medical clinics (37 programs), oral health and dentistry and counting (32 programs), health and nutrition awareness (21 programs), training and skill courses (14 programs), in addition to laboratory programs, visual and radiological examination and physiotherapy, which totaled 46 programs.

Al-Turki also pointed out that sports and entertainment will have a large share among these programs, as well as the campaign allocated a wing to educate young people about the dangers of drugs and harmful chemical compounds such as Al-Shabo and others, in addition to organizing a veterinary convoy to examine and treat livestock in the Qubba Center implemented by qualified veterinary consultants from the university, the campaign programs start from the morning and continue until the

evening for five continuous days to serve the people of the Qubba Center and its surroundings, who number more than twenty thousand people.

His Royal Highness Prince Dr. Faisal bin Mishaal bin Saud bin Abdulaziz, Governor of Qassim Region, witnessed on Monday, March 27, 2023, the signing of a memorandum of understanding on the "One Million Volunteer Hours Campaign" between the university and the branch of the Ministry of

Environment, Water and Agriculture in Qassim Region, and the National Center for Vegetation Cover Development and Combating Desertification in Qassim, in the presence of His Excellency Prof. Dr. Abdulrahman bin Hamad Al-Dawood, President of the University, where the agreement was signed by His Excellency the Vice President of the University, Dr. Muhammad Al-Saawi, and His Excellency the Director of the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture Branch in the Qassim Eng. Abdulaziz Al-Rujaie, and Director of the National Center for Vegetation Development and Combating Desertification in Qassim, Eng. Bader Al-Nugaidan, at his office in the Emirate of the region.

This memorandum comes from the objectives of the Kingdom's Vision 2030, and in line with the launch of His Highness the Crown Prince - may God protect him - the "Green Saudi Arabia" initiative and a continuation of the successes of the initiative of His Highness the Governor of Qassim Region "Qassim Land is Green", where this partnership came to enhance the achievement of these goals and raise the percentage of vegetation, afforestation and environmental values and increase the rate of community volunteering, through mechanisms and plans that ensure the achievement of the goals set through environmental initiatives, in addition to the participation of volunteer teams and university employees and students in farming, and improving Vegetation in national parks and university facilities.

His Highness praised the objectives of the initiative, which contributes to promoting the preservation of the environment, stressing the importance of involving all government sectors and volunteer teams to make this initiative comprehensive for all those wishing to volunteer to achieve the goals of the Kingdom's Vision 2030, noting the efforts achieved in promoting the cultivation and afforestation of national parks and university headquarters, in addition to cleaning campaigns for wild parks in the region, in order to achieve one million volunteer hours for university employees.

Volunteer dental convoys at the university treat 547 cases at the Dome Center

The volunteer dental convoys at the Faculty of Dentistry at the University, in cooperation with the Deanship of Community Service, organized its twenty-ninth convoy, which headed to the Qubba Center on Sunday morning 20/6/1443 AH, and provided its services to the beneficiaries until Thursday 24/6/1443 AH, at the Dome Celebration Center, as part of the university's initiative to activate the campaign of His Highness the Emir of the region "I am a Saudi who is proud of my identity".

191 volunteers participated in the convoy, including consultants, specialists, doctors, interns, male and female students, and the services provided by the convoy within 5 days included opening a file and treating 547 references and reviews in various men's and women's clinics, which contained clinics in the following specialties: (2 detection clinics, fillings clinic, pediatric dentistry, surgery and periodontal treatment) with a total of 18 clinics.

The convoy also included an educational aspect to raise community awareness about dental diseases and ways to prevent them, as 7 schools were visited and awareness and education services were provided to 639 students, education, consultations, and raising awareness about dental problems among male and female students.

For his part, the Dean of the College of Dentistry, Dr. Dhafer Al-Asmari, explained that this convoy comes within the university's initiative to activate the campaign of His Highness the Governor of Qassim Region to promote the national identity "I am a Saudi proud of my identity", pointing out that it is an extension of the series of volunteer convoys implemented by the college within the volunteer dental convoys program, which aims to provide voluntary dental services to remote areas in Qassim to promote oral and dental health.

Al-Asmari explained that these convoys provide distinguished treatment and awareness services to members of society, compatible with international quality standards, and contribute to spreading the culture of volunteer work among students, and working to prepare a generation of creative dentists in the field of volunteer work, as the number of convoys conducted by the program so far reached 29 convoys, and the number of beneficiaries of its services reached more than 35000,1000 beneficiaries, and more than <>,<> volunteers participated.

During the academic year 1435-34 AH, the Deanship of Community Service at Qassim University succeeded in providing more than “36” training programs between short and long training courses, where the total beneficiaries reached “2457” male and female trainees. The first and second in addition to the summer semester. At the time, the Deanship offered a number of short courses and programs throughout the year, as the “Family First Training Nights” program was presented to 309 beneficiaries, including four courses in the art of family management and education without violence, which give practical ideas towards distinct education and quadruple protection and how to Protect children from harassment, and another titled My Family and Technology, which offers practical ideas for employing technology in the family. The Deanship did not implement the “Training Nights of the Girl” program for 150 girls, which was presented during three different sessions, which are the mistakes in dealing with men and the other entitled “In the best calendar” as well as the art of communicating with oneself.

Medical and health care services provided by the University to more than 1,200 international students of 90 nationalities

Since the beginning of the outbreak of the Corona pandemic, the university has been keen to provide all the requirements of health care and subsistence to more than 1200 of its international students from 90 nationalities, to ensure their safety from this epidemic, as the Deanship of Student Affairs at the university continued to provide these services for almost four months, including the establishment of health quarries and specialized medical clinics, in cooperation with the university's Medical City, the Health Cluster, and the General Directorate of Health Affairs.

The university provided 3 health quarries, 15 medical staff, 8 mobile phones, and 10 volunteer clubs to provide all the needs and requirements of students, in addition to distributing more than 4,000 masks, 1,000 prayer mats, 5,000 gloves, 1,800 daily meals, and more than 10,000 sterilization and hygiene tools, and the university's grants department has booked travel tickets for students wishing to travel, ensure the validity of passports, renew expired passports in coordination with their embassies, and communicate with airlines to travel, to evacuate, confirm residence and extract Visa for those who wanted to travel.

The Deanship held a number of meetings with students to identify and provide them with their needs, where a command and control center was established to manage this crisis, under which 15 committees and a club for mobile in the student housing and a volunteer club to provide all services to these students, and set daily points of contact between beneficiaries and service providers, to provide all the requirements and daily needs for them, and allocated a number for emergencies around the clock, and sought to deport those who want to travel, where it has deported 900 students so far and is continuing with deportations after coordination With the relevant authorities, all preventive measures and precautionary measures have been taken in accordance with the

instructions received from the competent authorities to face this crisis and overcome its negative effects.

During the crisis, the university's housing department provided all the requirements for housing and follow-up maintenance work, and sought to provide the basic requirements for students from bringing tools outside the housing, and the roving also conducted a daily survey on the external and internal buildings of the suites, through their presence and housing inside the university to provide service around the clock, in addition to following up about 7 buildings inside the university, and following up the process of entering and exiting buildings, and making sure that there are no cases infected or suspected of being infected in some buildings.

For its part, the volunteer club contributed to the delivery of food items to each pavilion inside the pavilions of the buildings, and the provision of 3 meals with a total of 1800 meals per day to all students, where the volunteer student provides these meals and puts them inside the food containers to deliver them to students, according to models and numbers scheduled and accurate for each building, suite and room.

The medical department worked 24 hours a day during the crisis in coordination with the Command and Control Center, to provide treatment and medical consultations for all pathological cases, facilitate the access of students to the clinic and return to their rooms, dispense treatment and deliver medicines to the beneficiaries, and daily follow-up of all students with continuous examination inside their rooms, in addition to the presence of the clinic of the Ministry of Health in the student residence.

In turn, the Nutrition Department continued to secure successive meals and follow them closely inside the kitchen through specialists to ensure food safety and the number of meals that come out according to a specific schedule for all buildings and food delivery.

In turn, the Nutrition Department followed up on securing consecutive meals and closely following them inside the kitchen through specialists to ensure food safety, the number of meals that go out according to a specific schedule for all buildings and the delivery of food.

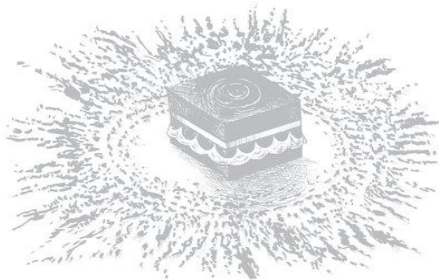

The Deanship of Community Service at the University, in cooperation with the General Directorate of Maintenance and Services, is participating in a campaign for afforestation in several different locations in the Qassim region over a period of 30 days, as part of the University's participation in the campaign of His Royal Highness Prince Dr. Faisal bin Meshaal bin Saud bin Abdul Aziz, Amir of Qassim "The land of Qassim is green", where His Excellency the President of the University, Prof. Dr. Abdulrahman bin Hamad Al-Daoud, inaugurated the University's participation in the sixth phase of the campaign on Monday, 16/3/1442 AH.



Through its participation in the campaign for the sixth time in a row, the University aims to expand the afforestation work and raise the percentage of total green spaces in the Qassim region, through the cultivation, dissemination and intensification of afforestation, where it aims to plant about 1,000 diverse seedlings, in different locations such as schools, mosques and a number of gardens in all governorates of the Qassim region, in coordination with the Ministry of Agriculture and the relevant authorities.

The Deanship's participation in the activities of the sixth phase of this campaign will continue over a period of 30 days, based on its mission towards the development and service of the community, and as an active participation towards achieving the objectives of the National Transformation Program and the Kingdom's Vision 2030 related to environmental protection, supporting afforestation, preserving natural vegetation cover, reducing pollution, raising air quality, beautifying cities, increasing the green area, raising the quality of life for individuals, and providing a healthy environment.

His Excellency Prof. Dr. Abdulrahman bin Hamad Al-Daoud, President of the University, on Monday, 16/3/1442 AH, sponsored the inauguration of the University's participation in the "Green Land of Qassim" campaign, launched by His Royal Highness Prince Dr. Faisal bin Meshaal bin Saud bin Abdulaziz, Governor of Qassim Region, which lasts for 30 days, where the University participates in its sixth phase, for the sixth time in a row.

The President of the University also inaugurated the "Plant It" initiative launched by the University on Twitter today, and will last for 30 years, where His Excellency planted the first seedlings of the campaign, and thanked the Deanship of Student Affairs and the relevant authorities involved, saying, "God willing, we will see the university city as a green land", in the presence of the Vice President of the University, Dr. Mohammed Al-Saawi, and the Vice President for Planning, Development and Quality, Prof. Dr. Khalid Al-Harbi, at the main entrance to the university city.

Following the inauguration of the university's participation, Al-Daoud inaugurated the exhibition accompanying the campaign, which is organized by the Deanship of Student Affairs, in cooperation with the College of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine, and the General Directorate of Services and Maintenance, and contains 10 pillars, starting with the corner of the stages of implementation of the campaign, which aims to plant 100,000 seedlings, to afforestation the headquarters in Meida, the afforestation of student housing, the scout camp, public and wild places in the region, in addition to the afforestation of the southern branch and its affiliated colleges, and the afforestation of the western branch and its colleges.

The exhibition contains several corners of the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine: the corner of soil types, the corner of tree and plant species, the corner of hydroponics, as well as the corner of care for the health of trees, the corner of modern irrigation types, in addition to the corner of ways to plant seedlings correctly, and the sanitary corner, in addition to a special corner for unjust firewood and its impact on the environment.

For its part, the General Directorate of Services at the University reviewed future afforestation projects through a plan to plant 1000 palms, planting shade trees with 4000 trees, rehabilitation and cultivation of faculty housing with more than 5000 trees, palms, shade trees, and flowering shrubs, in addition to planting 1000 shade trees and 800 Washington palms, and the administration reviewed afforestation statistics, which included in 2017 the planting of 37,300 seedlings, in 2018 planting 44,960 seedlings, and in 2019 planting 56,290 seedlings, with a total of 138,550 seedlings.

Through participation, the university aims to increase the green space in the university city, expand the afforestation work, and raise the percentage of total green spaces in it through the cultivation, dissemination and intensification of afforestation throughout the university city, while achieving the optimal utilization of treated water in irrigation works, which contributes to improving air quality and reducing temperatures in the university city, and all university sites in various governorates.
